Tender Information Document in respect of a tender offer for certain outstanding SEK denominated senior unsecured floating rate notes

Klarna Bank AB (publ), Reg. No. 556737-0431 (the “**Issuer**”) today announces its invitation to the holders (including any beneficial owners who hold their Notes (as defined below) via nominees or custodians) (the “**Noteholders**”) of its outstanding notes set out below (the “**Notes**”) to tender their Notes for purchase by the Issuer for cash (the “**Tender Offer**”) up to a maximum nominal amount equal to the Transaction Cap (as defined below). The Issuer has appointed Nordea Bank Abp (“**Nordea**”) to act as dealer manager (the “**Dealer Manager**”) in connection with the Tender Offer.

The Tender Offer is made on the terms and subject to the conditions set out below.

Purchase Price

Subject to the terms and conditions set out in this tender information document and the applicable minimum denomination in respect of the Notes, the Issuer offers to purchase the Notes at the purchase prices determined at the Pricing Time (as defined below) with reference to the relevant Fixed Purchase Spread set out below (the “**Purchase Prices**”, each a “**Purchase Price**”):

The Purchase Price for each of the respective Notes will be determined at the Pricing Time in accordance with market convention. The Purchase Price will be equal to the value of all remaining payments of principal and interest up to and including the maturity date of the relevant Note, discounted to the Settlement Date at the Floating Discount Rate (as defined below), less Accrued Interest (as defined below) for the respective Notes.

The discount rate will be calculated as the sum of (a) the 3 month Stibor rate and (b) the relevant Fixed Purchase Spread (the “**Floating Discount Rate**”). The Purchase Prices will be calculated using Bloomberg’s automatic forward curves in the “YAS” function in Bloomberg, inputting the relevant Floating Discount Rate.

The Issuer will also pay an amount equal to any accrued and unpaid interest on the Notes in accordance with the terms and conditions of the Notes (“**Accrued Interest**”).

Deadline

The Tender Offer expires at 12.00 CEST on 27 October 2022, unless extended, re-opened, withdrawn or terminated at the sole discretion of the Issuer (the “**Expiration Date**”). The pricing of the tender offer will take place on the Expiration Date at or around 14:00 CEST (the “**Pricing Time**”). The Issuer will announce the final Purchase Prices, the Tender Offer results (acting in its sole and absolute discretion) and whether any Notes will be accepted under the Tender Offer as soon as reasonably practicable after the Expiration Date. Settlement of the Tender Offer is expected to occur at or around 1 November 2022 (the “**Settlement Date**”). Settlement of the transactions pursuant to the Tender Offer will occur as a secondary trade via the Dealer Manager.

Subject to the terms and conditions set out in this tender information document and applicable law, the Issuer may, in its sole and absolute discretion, extend, re-open, amend or waive any condition of or terminate the Tender Offer at any time. Noteholders are advised to read carefully this document for the details of and information on the procedures for participating in the Tender Offer.

Transaction Cap

The tendered amount of Notes accepted by the Issuer will be capped at a total nominal amount equal to SEK 1,000,000,000 (the “**Transaction Cap**”), subject to the Issuer’s sole discretion of increasing, decreasing or removing the Transaction Cap. If the Issuer

decides to accept for purchase valid tender instructions made pursuant to the Tender Offer and the aggregate nominal amount of Notes validly tendered pursuant to the Tender Offer is greater than the Transaction Cap, the Issuer will accept such Notes for purchase on a pro-rata basis and on the principles described below, subject to the minimum denomination of SEK 2,000,000.

In the event of any scaling in the acceptance of Notes to be purchased, the Issuer will determine the allocation of the aggregate nominal amount of Notes accepted pursuant to the Tender Offer between each series of Notes in its sole and absolute discretion. Any scaling made by the Issuer is binding on all Noteholders who validly tendered their Bonds.

Purpose of the Tender Offer

The Tender Offer is being made as part of the Issuer's commitments to exercise active management of its balance sheet.

Participation

Noteholders can only participate in the Tender Offer by submitting a valid tender instruction. Only Noteholders who are clients of, and can execute a secondary trade upon settlement with, the Dealer Manager with all required know your customer (KYC) and similar documentation in place may participate in this Tender Offer and Noteholders must contact the Dealer Manager to receive an application form that includes the details of how to participate in the Tender Offer. Tender instructions given via the application form or via other form of tender instructions in a way that is permitted in accordance with what is stated in the application form are irrevocable by the Noteholders, except for in the limited circumstances described in the application form.
